



## Adolf "Al" Drachenberg

Adolf "Al" Drachenberg, 88, of Berlin, beloved husband of 58 years to Dorothy "Dottie" (Yost) Drachenberg, passed away Tuesday (March 14, 2017) at Middlesex Hospital in Middletown. 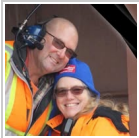
