Agnes Piekut Centurelli, 61, of Berlin, wife of John Centurelli, passed away Saturday May 30, 2009 at CT Hospice in Branford. Born in Germany, daughter of Mary Pirog Piekut of Southington and the late Andrew Piekut, she was a former New Britain resident, moving to Berlin in 1973. Agnes was a graduate of Mary Immaculate Academy in New Britain, and the St. Francis Hospital School of X-Ray.
