November 3, 1915 - November 2, 2005

Albert J. Muratori, 89, of New Britain, widower of Nellie Kuzyra Muratori, died Wednesday November 2, 2005 at Andrew House Healthcare in New Britain. Born in Meriden, he lived in New Britain most of his life. A World War II U.S. Army veteran and Purple Heart recipient, he served with the 10th Mountain Division in the European Theatre. Al was a union plumber working in the central CT area for over 30 years, retiring in 1972. He was a member of St. Ann's Church, New Britain.

Surviving is his son, Richard "Dick" Muratori and his companion Linda Manning of Farmington; a brother, Dino Muratori and his wife Kathy of New Britain; a sister, Lydia Poeta also of New Britain; several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by a brother Joseph "Ruggy" Muratori and a sister, Mary Garbellini.
