



## Alberta Post Catlin

October 24, 1918 - September 18, 2009

Alberta Post Catlin, age 90, formerly of New Britain and Southington, died on September 18, 2009 in Halfmoon, NY. She was born in Oakville, CT, and was a longtime New Britain resident until 1995, when she moved to Southington. In 2003, she moved to Queensbury, NY. She is survived by her son, Thomas Catlin and daughter-in-law Jude Hogan Catlin of Halfmoon, NY, three grandchildren, Sarah Landers and her husband Christopher of Saratoga, NY; Amanda Sykes and her husband Derrek of Shrewsbury, Mass; and Meghann Bodeau and her husband Todd of New Bedford, Mass; five great grandchildren; several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her husband Winton Catlin, a son, John Post Catlin, and two brothers, George and John Post.

Alberta was a Registered Nurse and was, for many years, the Coordinator of the New Britain General Hospital License Practical Nursing Educational Program. She was the Author of two State Board Exam Review Books. An active member of many committees at South Church, New Britain, she also was a docent for the New Britain Museum of American Art. She was a former member of the New Britain Board of Health, and was an appointed Justice of the Peace.
