



## Alexander J. DeLuzio

August 2, 2002 - November 4, 1915

Alexander J. DeLuzio, 87, of New Britain, husband of Susan Salvio DeLuzio, died Monday November 4, 2002 at the Jerome Home. A New Britain native and lifelong resident, he was a WWII US Army veteran. He worked at Manchester Modes for 40 years, retiring in 1980. Mr. DeLuzio was a member of St. Ann's Church; the New Britain VFW Post 511; the Disabled American Veterans; and the 169th Infantry Group.
