Alexander Joseph "Al" Shevchuk, 92, of New Britain, died Tuesday May 20, 2003 at Ridgeview Health Center in Cromwell. He was the widower of Mathilda "Tillie" Miller Shevchuk, who died January 27, 2002. Born in Manchester, he lived in New Britain since 1916.
