September 25, 1917 - October 18, 2001

Alexandra Capetan Swanson, 84, of School II Apartments, New Britain, widow of Bror E. Swanson, died Thursday Oct. 18, 2001 at New Britain General Hospital. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, she was a New Britain High graduate, Class of 1935. Mrs. Swanson was employed at the former American Hardware Company and later at Fafnir Bearing Company for 25 years, retiring in 1982. She was a member of St. George Greek Orthodox Church; sang in the church choir; and was a member of the Philoptochos Society and the Golden Rascals at the church. She was also a member of the New Britain Chapter, AARP and the New Britain Senior Citizens.
