Alice E. Morley Monzillo, 85, a former longtime New Britain resident, wife of the late Louis Monzillo, died Monday August 23, 2004 at New Britain General Hospital. Born in New Britain, daughter of the late Frederick and Alice Carey Morley, she lived briefly in Newington and Plainville. Alice was employed at North & Judd Manufacturing Company in New Britain as a Supervisor for over 30 years until her retirement in 1975. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in New Britain; the American Legion Auxiliary Post 6 in New Britain; and the New Britain Senior Citizens.
