



Aline Cusson Beaudoin

November 20, 1922 - November 20, 2011

Aline Cusson Beaudoin, 89, of Plainville, passed away Sunday November 20, 2011 at the Alzheimer's Resource Center in Southington. She was the widow of Marcel L. Beaudoin who died in 2006. Born in Roxton, Quebec, Canada, she lived in New Britain for 42 years, moving to Plainville in 1996. Aline was employed at General Electric in Plainville, the former North & Judd Manufacturing Company and later in the cafeteria at CCSU, retiring in 1974. She was a member of Our Lady of Mercy Church in Plainville and a former member of St. Maurice Church in New Britain.

Surviving are four sons, Serge Beaudoin and his wife Kathy of Southington; Alain Beaudoin of Cape Coral, FL and his former wife, Diane Beaudoin in Southington; Marc Beaudoin and his wife Lori of New Britain; and Richard Beaudoin and his wife Theresa also of Southington; two daughters, Carol Beaulieu and her husband Gaetan of Claire, New Brunswick, Canada; and Sandra Pindar and her husband Vernon of New Britain; a sister, Solange Menard of Granby, Quebec, Canada; 12 grandchildren; 9 great grandchildren; several nieces and nephews.
