Anne Serbin Havel, 91, of West Hartford, widow of Joseph Havel, passed away Friday August 9, 2013 at St. Francis Hospital in Hartford. Born in New Britain, she resided there most of her life until moving to Hamilton Heights in West Hartford in July of 2005. She loved living at Hamilton Heights and became a Goodwill Ambassador there. She was employed at Fafnir Bearing Company in New Britain for many years.
