Rev. Anne-Marie Brackett, 65, passed away unexpectedly at her home April 18, 2023 in Safety Harbor, FL with her canine companion, Keeva, by her side. Born in Bristol, CT to the late Vernon M. Brackett and Glenna (Sweet) and predeceased by a brother Jimmy.

Anne was a longtime member of the United Methodist Church in Hartford, CT becoming ordained as an Elder in June 2002 and served as Pastor at many churches in Rocky Hill, Hamden, Darien, Simsbury and Yalesville.
