Anne "Mickey" Siton Vater, 84, wife of Edward G. Vater, of New Britain, died Saturday September 2, 2006 at the Jerome Home in New Britain. A lifelong New Britain resident, Anne attended New Britain schools and was a longtime office manager for Dr. Herman Wolfson in Newington. She was an active member of St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church in New Britain; was an Air Raid Warden during World War II; was a former officer of Chamberlain School Mothers Club and a member of the PTA at the school.

Besides her husband Edward, she leaves two sons, Robert A. Vater and his wife Pamela of Westborough, Mass; and Paul E. Vater and his wife Joanny of Andover Township, New Jersey; a daughter, Carol A. Vater of Somerville, Mass; three brothers, Stanley Siton of New Britain; Francis W.
