Aphrodite "Freida" Legezios, 102, of New Britain, wife of the late Sotirios "Sam" Legezios, died Friday January 20, 2012. Born in Bursa, Turkey, Freida was raised in Greece and lived in Carlstadt NJ for 30 years before moving to New Britain in 1985. She was a graduate, Class of 1950, with a Bachelor's Degree from Evansville College in Indiana. Freida was an active member of St. George Greek Orthodox Church in New Britain; the American Association of University Women and a local book club here in New Britain. Freida, who knew three languages, was certified by the United Nations as a French Translator.

Surviving are two nieces, Lucille Greos of New Britain, and Dorothy Peltzer of Plainville; two nephews, Harry Stamatis of Plainville and Angelo Stamatis of New Britain; several grand-nieces and grand-nephews.

Funeral services are Thursday 10 AM at St. George Greek Orthodox Church, 301 West Main Street, New Britain, CT 06050 followed by burial in Fairview Cemetery. There are no calling hours.
