January 16, 1936 - July 25, 2008

Arnold J. Sargis, 72, of Berlin and John's Island, SC, passed away Friday July 25, 2008 in South Carolina after a long, courageous battle with cancer. Born in New Britain, he graduated from New Britain High School in 1954 and received a bachelors degree from Louisiana Tech. He served with the US Air Force for twenty years during the Korean and Vietnam Conflict and moved to Berlin in 1974. He was employed at Fafnir Bearing Company in New Britain and Newington and later at Wiremold in West Hartford, retiring in 1995. Arnold was a member of the Indian Hill Country Club in Newington and was a former volunteer for Junior Achievement in Central Connecticut.

Surviving is his wife, Carol Hoye Sargis; two sons, Scott Sargis and his wife Andrea of Duxbury, Mass; and Kevin Sargis and his wife Leslie of Lexington, Mass; a brother, Saul M. Sargis Jr. of Salisbury; two sisters, Elizabeth "Bette" Baldyga and Carole Sargis, both of Berlin; six grandchildren, Kyle, Kelsey, Madison, Colin, Makenna and Kendall Sargis; several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services are Wednesday 11 AM at the Erwin Chapel of South Church, 90 Main Street, New Britain. Burial with military honors will be in Maple Cemetery, Berlin.
