Arnold P. Schwartz, 87, of New Britain, husband of Helen-Mary (Delap) Schwartz, passed away Tuesday (November 26, 2019) at Autumn Lake Healthcare in New Britain. Born in New York, NY, Arnold was a former Hamden resident until moving to New Britain in 1983. He was employed as a Field Service Manager for Xerox Corporation for over 30 years until his retirement. He later volunteered for the Office of CT Atty. General Richard Blumenthal and then in the New Britain Mayor's Office for both Tim Stewart and Erin Stewart. Arnie was a member of St. Maurice Church of St. Katherine Drexel Parish; he volunteered and was former Advisory Board Chairman of the New Britain Salvation Army; was past president of the New Britain Lions Club; Chairman of RSVP; served on the board of Nutmeg TV and Constructive Workshop. 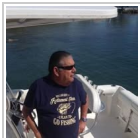
