



Arthur "Bud" Crandall

June 5, 1924 - February 19, 2023

Arthur E. "Bud" Crandall, 98, of Kensington, husband of Norma (Ulkus) Crandall, passed away February 19, 2023, with family by his side. Born in Berlin, son of the late Arthur Edgar Crandall and Anna Marie (Witz) Crandall, he was a former Wethersfield and Bristol resident, living in Kensington most of his life. Bud was a graduate of Berlin High School, served as Staff Sargent with the Army Air Corps during WWII and received his Bachelor's in Business Administration from UConn in 1949. He began his insurance career at The Phoenix Insurance Company, then joined The Traveler's in Hartford as their Director of Corporate Accounting, retiring in 1984 after 35 years. Bud was a member of the Kensington Congregational Church and volunteered for 17 years as the head AARP Tax Preparer in New Britain and Berlin.
