Barbara Peterson Maule, 66, of East Berlin, wife of Philip Maule, passed away Sunday May 6, 2012 at Hospital of Central Connecticut in New Britain. Born in New Britain, daughter of the late Arthur and Evelyn Pearson Peterson, she lived in East Berlin most of her life. A graduate of Berlin High School, class of 1964, she worked at United Mechanical Services in Meriden for over twenty years and later at Brittany Farms Healthcare Center for four years, retiring in April, 2011. Barbara was a member of St. Gabriel's Episcopal Church in East Berlin and was a charter member of the East Berlin Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary. Barbara touched many lives and was always there for those in need.
