Barbara C. Forster Voitowitz, 97, of New Britain, passed away Saturday September 27, 2008 at Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. She was the widow of William Martin Voitowitz, a retired New Britain Police Officer known to all as "The Major", who died in 1968.
