Barton F. Smith, 99, of New Britain, husband of Elizabeth "Lorayne" Talbot Smith, passed away Thursday January 23, 2014 at UConn Medical Center in Farmington. A lifelong New Britain resident, Bart was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1934, and was employed by the New Britain National Bank for 43 years, retiring in 1980. He was a member of St. Francis of Assisi Church in New Britain; the Stanley Golf Course Men's Club and the New Britain Elk's Lodge # 957. Bart was a kind, humble and gentle man; a friend to all.
