



## Beatrice Nimrod

September 17, 1924 - September 30, 2004

Beatrice Nimrod of New Britain died Thursday September 30, 2004 at St. Francis Hospital in Hartford. A New Britain native and lifelong resident, she was daughter of the late Joseph and Mary Nimrod. Bea was a member of New Britain High School Class of 1942 and graduated from St. Francis Hospital School of Nursing. An RN, she was manager of the Renal Dialysis Unit at St. Francis Hospital, where she worked for 50 years, retiring in 1996. She was a member of St. Thomas Assyrian Church of the East in New Britain. Beatrice is the beloved sister of Barbara Benjamin and her husband George of Clarkston, MI ; Julie Sargis and her husband Albert of New Britain; and Joseph Nimrod of Guilford.
