Benjamin Aivaz, 94, of New Britain, husband of the late Rose (Calistro) Aivaz, passed away Tuesday (January 23, 2018) at Apple Rehab in Plainville. Born in Persia, son of the late Joseph I. and Veronica (Shamlan) Aivaz, he lived in New Britain most of his life. Ben was a graduate of New Britain High School, class of 1941, and was a World War II US Navy Veteran. He was employed in the Shipping Department of the Hardware Division at Stanley Works for over 40 years, retiring in 1985.
