



Betty Pratt Dodson

July 5, 1909 - January 16, 2003

Betty Pratt Dodson, 93, of Kensington, died Thursday January 16, 2003 at The Masonic Health Care Center in Wallingford. She was the widow of Harvey Dodson, who died in 1989. Born in East Berlin, she lived in the Berlin-Kensington area for most of her life. A graduate of Middletown High School, class of 1925, she was a member and former deaconess of the Kensington Congregational Church. She was also a member of the Women's Service League, the Craft Club, the Monday Night Club, and the Kensington Garden Club.

Surviving is a son, Allen Dodson of Rocky Hill and his close friend, Diane Broff-Dodson of New Britain; a daughter, Joy White and her husband Richard of Southington; 3 grandchildren, April Dodson of New Britain; Catherine Sheldrick and her husband Peter of Bristol; and Eric White also of Bristol; a great grandson, Brett Sheldrick; several nieces and nephews.
