Betty L. Hill Tattersall, 77, of New Britain, beloved wife of Jack H. Tattersall, passed away peacefully at her home on Tuesday May 28, 2002 surrounded by her family.

Born in New Britain on Dec. 28, 1924, the daughter of the late Henry and Gladys Hill, she resided in New Britain and summered at Hammonasset her whole life.

She graduated in 1942 from New Britain High School and began her working career at Landers, Frary & Clark.
