



## Beverly Peterson Wennberg

October 30, 1937 - April 19, 2009

Beverly Peterson Wennberg, 71, of Southington, wife of Harry Oke Wennberg, passed away unexpectedly Sunday April 19, 2009 at her home. Born in New Britain, daughter of the late Morgan and Alice Reilly Peterson, she moved to Southington 22 years ago. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1956, she worked at Segur Insurance in Waterbury for four years, retiring in 1998. Previously, she worked at Stanley Works in New Britain and the Southington Savings Bank, Main Street Branch. Harry and Bev would have celebrated there 50th anniversary on May 23rd.

Besides her husband Harry, she leaves a daughter, Tracy Somers and her husband Doug of Southington; two grandsons, Kyle and Glen Somers; four sisters, Donna Peretz and her husband Sam of Niantic; Penny Nadile and her husband Robert of Meriden; Cheryl Parsons and her husband Robert of Bristol; and Debbie Peterson of Newington; several nieces and nephews.
