



Bruno "Flash" Romegialli

September 19, 1914 - June 8, 2005

Bruno "Flash" Romegialli, 90, of East Berlin, widower of Elizabeth Rota Romegialli, died Wednesday June 8, 2005 at New Britain General Hospital. Born in Cromwell, he was a lifelong East Berlin resident. A Bronze Star recipient, Bruno served with the U.S. Army in Europe during World War II. He was employed for the Town of Berlin Parks and Recreation Dept. for over 20 years, retiring in 1989. Bruno was a member of the East Berlin Volunteer Fire Department for over 50 years, and served as its Chief from 1961 to 1982. He was an avid baseball player with the former Mohawk Athletic Club; co-founded the Berlin Little League in 1950; was a charter member of the Berlin VFW Post; and was a member of both the Connecticut and New England Fire Chiefs Association.

Surviving is a son, Philip Romegialli and his wife Linda of East Berlin; a daughter, Rita Romegialli also of East Berlin; six grandchildren, Eric and Shawn Bowerman of Canajoharie, NY; Corey Bowerman of Burke, VA; Alison, Craig, and Adam Romegialli, all of East Berlin; two great granddaughters, Andrea and Alexis Bowerman; several nieces and nephews. Besides his wife, he was predeceased by a daughter, Marie Bowerman; three brothers, Ray, Victor, and Enzo Romegialli; and a sister, Della Burava.

Funeral services are Saturday 11 AM at Carlson Funeral Home, 45 Franklin Square, New Britain. Burial with military honors will be in Wilcox Cemetery,
