Burton J. Robinson, 88, of Kensington, husband of Ruth Peterson Robinson, died Saturday October 13, 2007 at Ledgecrest Care Center in Kensington. Born in New Britain, he lived in Kensington since 1954. A graduate of New Britain High School. Class of 1937, he was a World War II U.S. Army veteran. Burt was employed at the Reingold Breweries office in Hartford for 25 years, until 1976, he then worked for the town of Berlin in the School Department retiring in 1984.
