Carl P. Clark Jr., 62, of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, formerly of New Britain, passed away Monday April 20, 2009 at the Methodist Medical Center in Oak Ridge. Born in New Britain, son of the late Carl P. Clark Sr. and Mary Rossman Clark, he moved to Oak Ridge in 2003. Carl is a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1965, and served in the US Air Force during the Vietnam Conflict. He was employed as Planning Manager at Fafnir Bearing Company in New Britain for 24 years, before becoming the Residence Director of the New Britain YMCA for 9 years, retiring in 2003. He was a member of St. Francis of Assisi Church in New Britain and was a former Eucharistic Minister.
