Carlton H. Johnson, 66, of New Britain, husband of Ann Lattarulo Johnson, passed away Monday December 31, 2007 at Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A lifelong New Britain resident, he graduated from New Britain High School in 1960. Carlton owned and operated the Corbins Corner Barber Shop in West Hartford for 20 years, and later the East Street Barber Shop in New Britain for 5 years, retiring in 1999.
