Carmella (Sereno) "Millie" Paci, 97, of New Britain, widow of Primo Paci passed away Sunday (August 18, 2024) at Jerome Home in New Britain. Millie met Primo at a Big Band dance at Lake Compounce and married him in 1950. Born in New Britain on Sept 26, 1926, she was daughter of the late Saverio and Olympia (Germinara) Sereno. She graduated from New Britain High School, Class of 1944 and was a Typist in the Service Department at Fafnir Bearing Company for 43 years, retiring in 1989.
