



## Carmine "Saverio" Pugliese

July 16, 1933 - January 10, 2006

Carmine "Saverio" Pugliese, 72, widower of Doris Simeone Pugliese who died in 1997, formerly of Berlin, passed away Tuesday January 10, 2006 . Born in Putignano, Bari, Italy, he was son of the late Maria and Giuseppe Pugliese. He worked at Fafnir Bearing Company for many years, and after retiring, he was employed at Connecticut Tire. Saverio lived in Berlin for 50 years, until moving to Barkhamsted in 2003. Some of his favorite hobbies included gardening, cooking, woodworking and camping with his RV buddies at Hammonasset.
