July 22, 1913 - December 16, 2008

Charles P. Goss, 95, of Bloomfield, passed away on December 16, 2008 at Hartford Hospital. Charlie, as he was known to everyone, was the son of Stanley T. and Louise P. Goss and was born at home on Russell St. in New Britain, Connecticut on July 22, 1913. He was a resident of New Britain for his whole life until he moved to Duncaster in Bloomfield in 2005.

Charlie was a 1932 graduate of Deerfield Academy and a 1936 graduate of Amherst College. Beginning with summers during his college years, he worked for The Goss and DeLeeuw Machine Company in Kensington until it was dissolved in 2005. He was the president of the company from 1950 until 1979 and remained as Chairman of the Board of Directors until 2005. For many years he was an expert marksman at the Bell City Rifle Club.

Besides his devotion to his company, Charlie was an extremely generous alumnus and contributor to numerous organizations. He was a member of the First Church of Christ, Congregational in New Britain.

He is survived by his sister, Elizabeth G. Young of Bloomfield; by his nephew, George W. Young, Jr. and his wife Cynthia of Falmouth, Maine; by his niece, Nancy Y. Luke and her husband George of Santa Rosa, California; by several grandnephews and grandnieces; and by his friend Nancy Cutter of New Britain. He was predeceased by his sister, Helen P. G. Vibberts; and by his

nephew, Douglas W. Young.

A memorial service is planned for 11:00 AM on Saturday, January 31, 2009 in the meeting room of the main building at Duncaster Retirement Community, Loeffler Rd., Bloomfield, CT 06002.
