Charles Oickle, 78, of New Britain, died Saturday Nov. 17, 2001. Born in Worcester, Mass., he lived in New Britain since 1948. A graduate of North High School in Worcester, he graduated from Worcester Polytechnic Institute in 1944 and the U.S. Navel Academy, and served in the Navy during WWII. Mr. Oickle retired as Manager of Research Engineering in 1979 after 33 years with the United Technologies Research Division in East Hartford. An avid golfer, he was a member of the Country Club of Farmington, where he was runner-up for the championship in 1978 and 1979. He was a member of First Lutheran Church in New Britain.

Surviving is his wife Carol Olson Oickle; a son, Richard C. Oickle of Bothell, Washington; a daughter, Barbara Barton and her husband Robert of Shipman, Virginia; 3 grandchildren, Holly Burton, Jon and Lauren Oickle; a brother, George Oickle and his wife Joyce of Wethersfield; a sister-in-law, Eileen Oickle of Glen Burnie, Maryland; several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by a daughter, Carolyn Louise Oickle and 2 brothers, Red and Buster Oickle.

A memorial service will be held Tuesday 10 AM in the Chapel of First Lutheran Church, 77 Franklin Sq., New Britain. There are no calling hours. Memorial donations may be made to a charity of the donors choice. Carlson Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
