April 19, 1915 - July 28, 2007

Charles "Carlo" Todeschini, 92, of Berlin, husband of AnneWassil Todeschini, died Saturday at his home after a short illness with his family at his side. Born in New Haven, he was a former Higganum resident moving to Berlin in 1956. A World War II US army veteran, he was a set-up man in the Hand Tools division of the New Britain Machine Company for 45 years, retiring in 1983. He was a member of Sacred Heart Church of East Berlin; the New Britain VFW 511 Post; and was a former Higganum Volunteer Fire department member.

Besides his wife Anne, he leaves six daughters, Gail Ouellette of Farmington; Nancy Bienkowski and her husband Gary of Berlin; Carla Todeschini and her husband Jeff Glatz of Middletown; Lisa Beckman and her husband Ronald of East Berlin; Julie Nelson and her husband Richard of Niantic; and Anne Small and her husband Craig of Madison; nine grandchildren; several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by three sisters and four brothers.
