



## Cherry Chin Jayne

November 25, 1929 - January 13, 2013

Cherry Chin Jayne, 83, of New Britain, passed away Sunday January 13, 2013 after a short illness. Born in Canton, China, she was a longtime New Britain resident. Cherry was the widow of Stanley Chin Jayne who was the co-proprietor of the Char Far, a popular restaurant for many years, on Main Street in New Britain.
