Cynthia (Cahill) Kuehn, 69, of Kensington, wife of Theodore “Ted” Kuehn, passed away Monday (April 27, 2020) at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A New Britain native, daughter of the late William and Madeline (Vitale) Cahill, she lived in Kensington since 1971. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1968, she received her Nurse’s Degree (RN) from Capital Community College. Cynthia worked at the Hartford Visiting Nurses Association and later at the Berlin VNA as Clinical Supervisor for the Town of Berlin for 15 years, retiring in 2018. She was a member of St. Paul Church in Kensington and the Kensington Volunteer Fire Department and former Ambulance Service.
