



## Daniel S. Majewski

June 17, 1929 - March 7, 2008

Daniel S. Majewski, 81, a life-long resident of New Britain and Kensington passed away peacefully on Friday, March 7, 2008 in Carol Stream, Illinois. He was born and raised in New Britain. Dan graduated from New Britain High School in 1944 and went on to receive a bachelor's degree from Arnold Teachers College. He also earned a master's degree from Central Connecticut State University, and a sixth-year teaching certificate from the University of Hartford.

Dan was a life-long athlete and sports enthusiast. He excelled in a wide range of sports. In high school, Dan was a star athlete, and was selected for All-State honors in football, basketball and baseball. He was recruited by, and briefly attended, The University of Alabama on a football scholarship. Dan was an accomplished golfer and participated in many tournaments in the New England area. He also was an avid bowler and softball player. In 1998, he was named to the New Britain Sports Hall of Fame.

Dan was employed as a Physical Education Teacher at Washington and Pulaski Junior High Schools in New Britain until his retirement in 1987. Dan proudly served his country in the US army during the Korean Conflict. He was stationed in Alaska from 1951 to 1953. Daniel was a member of St. Paul's Catholic Church in Kensington. He was also a member of the Independent Political Club in New Britain and the Italian Political Independent Club in

Kensington.

Dan was preceded in death by his wife, Mitzi Dahlberg, and his son Danny. He is survived by his two daughters, Debbie Patrick Hoffman of Glen Ellyn, Illinois and Kim Chris Sheehey of Paris, France. The youngest of nine children, Dan is survived by his sister Lola O'Connor of New Britain. Dan leaves four adoring grandchildren; Kathryn and Elizabeth Hoffman, and Daniel and Caroline Sheehey.
