Dawn (Scott) Guite, 92, of Old Saybrook, widow of Wilfred “Bill” Guite, passed away Saturday (December 17, 2016) at her home in Old Saybrook. Dawn was the adopted daughter of the late William and Charlotte (Nearing) Scott, and lived in Berlin for 53 years before moving to Meriden and was a graduate of Berlin High School, Class of 1942. She attended the Berlin Congregational Church, taught church school for several years and had been a member of the choir. She was employed at the Fafnir Bearing Co before joining the Navy WAVES during World War II. Upon completion of her tour of duty in 1946, she attended the Boston Bouve College of Physical Therapy. Briefly she worked for the International Gift Center in Berlin and then for Sage –Allen at West Farms Mall for 18 years before retiring in 1993.

In her passing she leaves to be cherished in her memory, a son, Jonathan Guite of Meriden; a daughter, Dawn Guite of Forestville; a daughter-in-law, Sharon (Westman) Guite of Kensington; five grandchildren, Kevin Guite, Brian Guite and his wife Haley, Heather Lynn Misterka and her husband Tim, and Josh and Shawn Guite both of Colorado; three great grandchildren, Aria and Cayden Guite; and Logan Misterka.
