Dennis R. Kleszcz, 38, of Kensington, beloved husband of Helene Beaudoin Kleszcz, died Sunday October 17, 2004. Born in New Britain, son of Dennis and Suzanne Nadeau Kleszcz, he was a graduate of E.C. Goodwin Technical School in New Britain, class of 1984, and has been a Kensington resident the last four years. Dennis was employed as a chef at several area restaurants, including Portabella's, Ultimate Billiards, J. Timothy's, and Pereira's.
