Dewey A. Main, 75, of New Britain, husband of Leonor "Lee" Faria Main, died Sunday February 12, 2006. A native and former Plainville resident, he moved to New Britain in 1967. Dewey was a U.S. Army veteran, serving during the Korean Conflict and was employed at the former American Hardware Company, then Emhart Corporation and later becoming the Corbin-Russwin Division of Black & Decker for 46 years, retiring in 1992. Dewey was a member of St. John the Evangelist Church in New Britain.
