



Diane (DiCosimo) Dobruck

Diane (DiCosimo) Dobruck, 68, of New Britain, passed away peacefully, surrounded by her loving family, on Friday (July 25, 2025) at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A New Britain native, she was daughter of the late Geno and Ida (Renzoni) DiCosimo and lived in New Britain most of her life. Diane was a graduate of Pulaski High School, Class of 1974, and worked as an EMT for New Britain EMS for about 10 years. She was also a CNA for many years, and later worked as part of facilities management at Wellspring Church in Kensington before retiring in 2014.

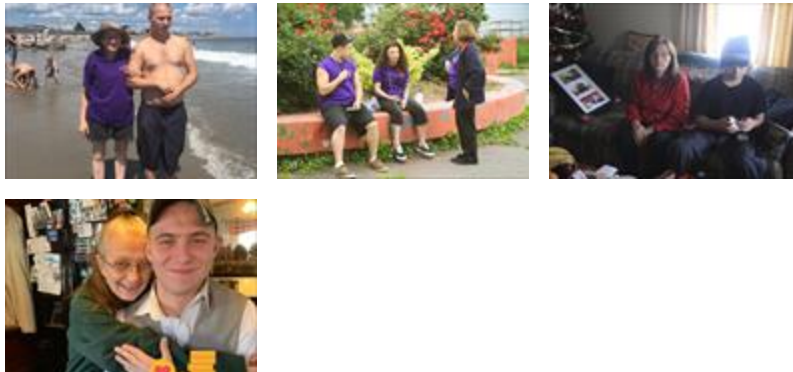
