Donald P. Bradley, 69, of Hemlock Ridge, Kensington, died Saturday Nov. 17, 2001 at New Britain General Hospital. Born in New Britain, he lived in Kensington since 1967. He graduated from Mt. St. Charles Academy in Woonsocket, Rhode Island and received his bachelors degree from Boston College in 1955. A U.S. Navy veteran, he was employed at Morton Industries in Chicopee, Mass. for 25 years, retiring in 1994.

Mr. Bradley was a member of St. Maurice Church; was the Eucharistic Minister at St. Maurice Church and the Jerome Home; and was a member of the Shuttle Meadow Country Club.
