Donald N. Hoffman, 74, of Plantsville, husband of June Knopf Hoffman died Monday Aug. 20, 2001 at New Britain General Hospital. Born in New Britain, he was a lifelong Kensington resident, moving to Plantsville in 1999. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1945, he served with the U.S. Navy at the end of World War II. Mr. Hoffman worked at the Kensington Post Office for 20 years, retiring in 1989. During his retirement, he made picnic tables, quilt racks, and doll houses for many friends, family and neighbors at his Kensington Home, where the Hoffman's lived for 46 years. He was a member of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church and Pvt. Walter J. Smith Post, VFW in New Britain.

Besides his wife June, he leaves a daughter, Jerry Forrest of Plantsville; 2 sons, Paul Hoffman and his wife Linda of Plainville; and David Hoffman and his wife Roxanne of Colchester; 6 grandchildren; several nieces and nephews. Donald was predeceased by a sister, Lillian "Pat" Schoech and 2 brothers, Oswald and Edward Hoffman.
