Dorothy “Dottie” (Yost) Drachenberg, 86, of Meriden, wife of the late Adolf “Al” Drachenberg, passed away peacefully Sunday (January 31, 2021) at The Village at Kensington Place in Meriden. Born in New Britain, Dottie was a Berlin resident since 1964 and later moved to Meriden in 2018.
