



Dr. Peter Rinaudo

January 25, 1920 - October 19, 2002

Dr. Peter A Rinaudo, 82, husband of Santina “Tina” Sciandra Rinaudo, of Berlin, died Saturday October 19th at Ridgeview Health Care Center in Cromwell. Born in Williamsburg, VA, son of Giocondo and Secondina Prucca Rinaudo, he lived in Norwich and New Haven until moving to Berlin in 1967. Dr. Rinaudo was formerly employed at the Norwich State Hospital and the West Haven VA Medical Center until becoming the Chief of Pathology at the Newington VA Medical Center. He was also a Professor at the Uconn Medical Center in Farmington. He retired in 1988. Dr. Rinaudo was a member of St. Paul’s Church in Kensington.

Besides his wife “Tina”, he is survived by a brother, Silvio Rinaudo and his wife Maria Theresa of Mondovi, Italy.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday 10 AM at Carlson Funeral Home 45 Franklin Square in New Britain. A Mass of Christian Burial will follow in St. Mary’s Cemetery.
