



Dr. Walter P. Gerent

March 27, 1922 - February 17, 2021

Dr. Walter Gerent, 98, of West Hartford, husband of Irene (Harasymiw) Gerent, passed away Wednesday (February 17, 2021) at UConn Health Center in Farmington. Born in the Ukraine, Walter was a former New Britain resident until moving to West Hartford in 1977. He served with the U.S. Navy during World War II, and is a graduate of Drexel University Medical School, where he also received his Doctorate. He was employed as a Physician at Pratt & Whitney Aircraft and had a private practice in Hartford until his retirement in 1987. He was a member of St. Mary Ukrainian Orthodox Church in New Britain and the American Medical Association.

Besides his wife Irene, he is survived by relatives in both the USA and Ukraine. Walter was predeceased by his sister Sonya Gerent.

Funeral services are Saturday 10 AM at St. Mary Ukrainian Orthodox Church, 54 Winter Street, New Britain, CT 06051. Burial with military honors will follow in the church cemetery.
