Earl H. Vogt, 92, of New Britain, husband of Gladys Tuttle Vogt, passed away Saturday November 13, 2010 at Brittany Farm Health Care Center in New Britain. A lifelong New Britain resident and graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1938, Earl was a World War II US Army Air Corps veteran serving in the China-Burma-India Campaign. He was employed by the State of CT Department of Transportation for 17 years, retiring in 1982. He was an active member for over 60 years of the Trinity United Methodist Church until its closing several years ago. Earl was past Commander of the Pvt. Walter J. Smith Post VFW. A devoted family man, he enjoyed traveling, going to horse races and seeing his friends at the New Britain Senior Center. He was an avid Yankee, New York Giants and UConn basketball fan.

Besides his wife Gladys of 61 years, he is survived by a devoted son, Richard E. Vogt of New Britain; a devoted daughter and son-in-law, Gail and Richard Tremblay of Rocky Hill; a granddaughter and her husband Cori and Marc Hass of Wallingford; a grandson, Richard Vogt also of Wallingford; a nephew William Vogt and several cousins. Earl was predeceased by a brother, Justus Vogt.
