



Edna Anderson Weitzke

November 23, 1917 - February 3, 2006

Edna Anderson Weitzke, 88, of Avery Heights, Hartford and Wayne, Maine, wife of William J. Weitzke, Sr., died Friday February 3, 2006 at Hartford Hospital. Born in New Britain, she was a former West Hartford and Farmington resident for 36 years, moving to Hartford in 2000. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1936 and St. Raphael's School of Nursing, she served as a First Lieutenant in the Army Nurse Corp. during World War II. She was a RN in the Obstetric Unit at New Britain General Hospital for 20 years, retiring in 1978. Edna was a member of First Church of Christ, Congregational in West Hartford, where she was a former Sunday School Teacher and a member of the Ladies Guild. She was a 50 year member and Past Matron of Fredericka Chapter, Order of Eastern Star; was a former Tour Director at the Connecticut State Capital; a longtime volunteer for the Red Cross Blood Bank; was former President of the West Hartford Women's Club and was active with several area bridge groups. Edna and her husband were former President's of the Rip Snorters Square Dance Club in West Hartford. She was also a member of the Pymegers of Plainville. Edna and her husband Bill traveled extensively.

Besides her husband Bill of 59 years, she leaves a son, William J. Weitzke, Jr and his wife Katie of Meriden; a daughter, Lynn Weitzke of Chadds Ford, PA and her significant other, Bill Gerrish of Bristol; two granddaughters, Dr. Elizabeth Weitzke and her fiancé David Kovar of Chicago, IL; and Jill Weitzke

and her husband Lawrence Bald of Bristol; a great granddaughter, Danielle Weitzke of Bristol; several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by a son, Mark Weitzke and a brother, John E. Anderson.
