Edward Blair, 94, of Southington, passed away Thursday January 9, 2003 at Southington Care Center surrounded by his family. A New Britain native and longtime resident, he lived in Hudson FLA for 24 years until moving to Southington in 1999. Mr. Blair was employed at Marlin-Rockwell in Plainville for 35 years, retiring in 1973, and also served as assistant golf pro under Willie Whelan at Shuttle Meadow Country Club in the 40's and early 50's. An avid bowler and fisherman, his true passion was golf. He was a member of St. Matthews Lutheran Church and the Donau Club in New Britain. He was a former member of the New Britain Democratic Town Committee and the Mr. & Mrs. Club at the church; former deacon at the church and past president of the PTL at St. Matthews Lutheran School.

He leaves his wife Agnes Hawley Christopherson-Blair; 3 daughters, Susan Hoban and her husband James of Severna Park, MD; Marilyn Miller and her husband Frank and Roberta Kuhr and her husband Walter, all of Southington; 12 grandchildren; 9 great grandchildren; several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his first wife Emma "Amy" Fiedler Blair, who died in 1978 and by 8 brothers and sisters, Charles, Adolph, August, John, and Joseph Blair; Emma Cronin, Ann Whelan, and Pauline Zering.
