



## Elaine Fleckstein Nordgren

March 6, 1909 - December 24, 2005

Elaine Fleckenstein Nordgren, 96, of New Britain, widow of Julius W. Nordgren, died Saturday December 24, 2005 at Cherry Brook Nursing Center in Canton. Born in Minneapolis, Minnesota, she lived in New Britain for the past 57 years. Elaine received her undergraduate degree from Columbia University in New York City and received her Masters Degree from Teachers College of Connecticut now CCSU. She was an elementary teacher at the Smalley School in New Britain for 13 years, retiring in 1974. A member of the First Lutheran Church, she was part of its Caring Network; and was also active with the Auxiliary of the Salvation Army and the YWCA.

Surviving are two sons, Marc Nordgren and his wife Margaret of Barkhamsted; and Ralph Nordgren and his wife Nancy of Colchester; four grandchildren, Tyler and Andrew Nordgren of Colchester, Travis Nordgren of Boulder, Colorado, and Kendra Nordgren of New Britain; a great grandson, Kieran; several nieces and nephews.
