Elaine White Wishart, 79, of Meriden, widow of Donald G. Wishart Sr., died Saturday June 3, 2006 at her home. Born in Brandonville, PA, she was a former New Britain resident, moving to Meriden in 1954. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1944, she was employed at Northeast Utilities in Berlin for 12 years, retiring in 1994. Following her retirement, she worked at Mid-State VNA and Hospice in Meriden. Elaine was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Meriden and was a former church choir member. She also volunteered for the Meriden Office of the American Cancer Society in the "Reach to Recovery" Program.

Surviving are two sons, Craig Wishart and his wife Marybeth of Middletown; and Donald Wishart Jr. and his wife Nancy of Vero Beach, Florida; two daughters, Holly Wishart of Meriden and Hope Hedberg and her husband Rev. Paul Hedberg of Homewood, IL; two brothers, Wayne White of Plantsville and Foster White of Natosulga, AL; a sister, Phyllis Ohlsen of Cromwell; six grandchildren, Eric and Peder Hedberg; Ryan, Alyssa, Shelley, and Heather Wishart; several nieces and nephews.
